## **1. Purpose**

To provide an update on the implementation of the training programme for aspiring SHI's on Property and Development

## **2. Background**

- Women Summit held on 16 and 17 August 2019 presided by the Hon MEC, in that summit women stakeholders expressed some interest and need to participate in the social housing programme .
- Resolution was taken that information sessions will be held in all districts to empower them.



- Information session on Social Housing were held in all 11 District Municipalities.
- A total of 218 interested parties.
- Out of the 218 participants, 11 applied for accreditation, 5 were accredited and 6 are still in the process of applications.
- The sessions took place between 16 September 2019 and 05 February 2020
- From the training, need was identified to provide the basic course on Property Management and Development



- Which then lead to engagement meetings with Institutions of higher Learning, Capacity Building, Social Housings and CRU to discuss the training programme and an Agreement reached on the training methodology.

# Training content and delivery model

The higher learning institutions will be based in KZN and registered with the Department of higher education. The institution will need to provide a comprehensive training package.

## **Target Audience**

- An invitation will be sent out to all Aspiring and accredited SHIs with a deadline to confirm attendance stating that space is limited.

- **Course Content**

The Service Provider will develop a training package

- ❖ Property Development
- ❖ Property Finance
- ❖ Property evaluation
- ❖ Property Management
- ❖ Project Management



## **Time Frame**

Initially the Project was planned to take place in November 2020 but due to the COVID 19 pandemic which coursed delays in appointment of a service Provider, the project is anticipated to commence beginning of March 2021.
