1. Purpose

To provide an update on the implementation of the training programme for aspiring SHI's on Property and Development

2. Background

- Women Summit held on 16 and 17 August 2019 officiated by the Hon MEC, in that summit women stakeholders expressed some interest and need to participate in the social housing programme .
- Resolution was taken that information sessions will be held in all districts to empower them



- Engagement meetings with Institution of higher Learning, Capacity Building, Property Management , CRU and Social Housings held to discuss the training programme. Consensus reached on the training methodology



- Information session on Social Housing were held in all 11 District Municipalities.
- A total of 218 interested parties, mostly women were empowered.
- Out of the 218 participants, 11 applied for accreditation, 5 were accredited and 6 are still in the process of applications.
- Training took place between 16 September 2019 and 05 February 2020
- From the training, need was identified to provide the basic course on Property Management and Development

Training content and delivery model

Target Audience

- 50 Aspiring and accredited SHIs, mostly women to be selected from database. To start with eThekwin and Ilembe District as the first group of trainees.

Course Content

The Service Provider will develop a training package

- ❖ Property Finance
- ❖ Property Valuation
- ❖ Property Management
- ❖ Project Management



Time frame

The training will commence as soon as the Submission is approved. It is anticipated that it will start in the first week of November 2020.

Duration-2 days per session
