IZIHLATHI zivakashele izindlebe kubantu baseLamontville akade behlala emjondolo ngesikhathi iMeya yeTheku, uMhuz Mxolisi Kaunda, ithula uhlelo lwezindlu lukaRi bilhon.

UKaunda uthe imindeni isizohlala ezindlini ezisesimeni esikahle emuva kokuhlala emjondolo.

Uthe sezizonke izindlu eKuthuleni, eLamontville, zizoba wu-400.

“Ziwu-180 izindlu esesizakhiwe lana eKuthuleni, sezizonke zizoba wu-400. Izindlu zizobuyisa isithunzi sabantu bakithi, kubuye ithemba. Kukhona abasuswe kule ndawo bayiswa eQueensburgh bakhelwa izindlu ezivu-400. Bazothola ubunikazi bezindlu, bathole amanzi, ugesi nakho konke okuzoqinisekisa ukutini bahlala endaweni esesimeni esikahle,” kusho

uKaunda.

Uthe uma izindlu seziphelile uMasipala weTheku wenza isiqiniseko sokuthi ziya kubantu abafanele ngokubanika okhaye namatayitela ezandleni ukuze kungabi bikho abangena ngodli ezindlini zabanye.

Kwezinye izinhlelo zezindlu kuke kwaba nabazibiza ngamasosha oMkhonto weSizwe akade bengena ngodi ezindlini ezisanda kwakhiwa obekuhlndwe ukuthi zidluliselwe kubanikazi bazo.

Kule minyaka edlule uKaunda uthe sebakhe izindlu ezingapheszu kuka-12 000 kanti eminyakeni ezayo bazokwakhala izindlu eziphakathi kuka-170 000 kuya ku-270 000 ezinayo vonke inggalasizinda edingekayo.

Ngesikhathi uKaunda ekhuluma nabezindaba abantu baseLamontville bebezabule bezwakala bekhiza abanye bethi basuka emjondolo bangena ezindlini ezinhle.

Praise and Ululating fill the streets of eKuthuleni, Lamontville

EThekwini Municipality Mayor, Mr. Mxolisi Kaunda has once again put smiles on the faces of the residents of eKuthuleni in Lamontville as he launched a R1 billion Housing Programme yesterday. “This programme is aimed at restoring the dignity of our people and strengthening their faith”, the Mayor said. The programme has completed 180 units to date out of 400 units.

Mr. Kaunda later shared that the residents of eKuthuleni will not only be receiving houses however they will also be receiving home ownership (title deeds), water supply, electricity and other essentials needed for households. He also mentioned that to ensure that there is fair allocation of houses, the municipality will be handing over the keys and title deed to the beneficiary personally as previously there has been unauthorized entry to houses.

The municipality has built over 12 000 houses in previous years and aims to build an estimated 170 000 to 270 000 which will have all the essentials needed. The residents of eKuthuleni were ululating, dancing and praising the municipality saying, “we have moved from informal settlements into beautiful houses”.
